

Sherburne Electric Rates

A Purchased Power Adjustment (PPA) is computed each month and is an additional charge.

The rates shown in the tables have been effective since Dec 1, 1992.

Meters are read between the 10th and the 25th of the month (usually on the 15th) and invoices rendered on the first of the next month.

A late payment charge rate of 1½ percent per month will be applied on the unpaid balance of any prior bill including interest thereon.

An Industrial Service Class Rate is available. Contact the Electric Department for details regarding the Industrial Class Rate.
